

USA DIRECTOR MESSAGE

Dear Friends of UCE,

This past year has been an eventful and exciting year for UCE! First of all, I extend my sincerest thanks to you, our generous donors, because you came forth to match the large anonymous grant which blessed UCE in 2018. A boost like this keeps UCE going strong in Africa. Here in the USA, we completed a very special project, "A Light Shines in Africa," a beautiful, compelling, sixminute video which tells the UCE story and includes interviews of UCE co-founders, Drs. Kim and Ken Dernovsek, and footage of UCE outreaches in Burundi, Tanzania, and Uganda. In Colorado, the Denver Guild of the Catholic Medical Association invited Dr. Kim Dernovsek to be their quest speaker on "The Medical Perspective on Chastity." UCE was further gifted by visits here of three key UCE leaders--at minimal cost to the ministry because they had been brought to the USA by other organizations! Fr. Deusdedit, Director of UCE-Masaka Uganda, shared UCE program highlights with our Colorado UCE supporters. UCE Africa Director, Mr Isaac Lema presented at an "Afternoon in Africa" and outlined his vision to the UCE Board for a UCE- East Africa Conference of all teams in 2020. When UCE-Burundi pioneer, Anglican Archbishop Martin Nyaboho was here, he explained how UCE is critical in the fight against HIV/AIDS because it is the only organization still left in his country with the mission to prevent HIV/AIDS! Also, I travelled to UCE-Burundi for the first time to meet with the UCE-Burundi team in-person and observe outreaches there. What a great year!

During my trip to Burundi, the magnitude of the UCE message hit hard when I participated with the UCE team in a one-hour radio broadcast. We described on-air how we do a youth outreach and gave testimonies, scripture, and medical facts as to why chastity was best for body and soul. At the end of the show, a Burundian man, "Enoch," called in and gratefully stated that he had been convinced during the broadcast that he must change his ways and follow the UCE message, emphasizing, "...from now on, I will be faithful to my wife." There is no doubt that UCE also brings a powerful message for couples.

Most importantly, UCE's programs in Uganda, Burundi and Tanzania continue strong. In the past year alone, UCE did 277 outreaches, grew to 74 UCE Clubs and saw 44,646 youth sign chastity commitment cards! Additionally UCE spread its message on the radio waves, in followup counseling to students, in UCE Clubs, from the pulpit on UCE "Chastity Sunday" and taught faithfulness to married couples.

Since UCE began in 2004, over 475,258 UCE chastity cards have been signed. Not unexpectedly, schools in all countries report dramatic teen pregnancy reduction. God Bless you for your continuing support which allows this beautiful ministry to thrive. As you review this Annual Report, I hope you will be inspired by God's work through UCE and consider a generous gift during this year marking UCE's 15th Anniversary! Together, we will continue to make a difference!





From 2,658 youth who were tested in Rumonge county, four of them were already suffering with HIV/AIDS. Archbishop Martin Nyaboho, UCE-Burundi pioneer thanked God and UCE for helping fight HIV/AIDS in the region.

"Spread the UCE Message to **Every Corner of the Diocese**"





Kasese is located in western Uganda and includes mountainous areas, creating the additional challenge of navigating mountain roads or walking trails over difficult terrain to reach the rural youth.



UCE Programs Decrease Teen Pregnancy Rates

Pregnancy Rate Reduction after UCE Outreaches 2018-2019

School (Ages 15-19)	Before UCE	After UCE	Comments (Head Teachers/UCE Club Patrons)	
Nyakiyumbu SS	8	1	Since the outreach there is a great change in students' sexual behavior. The myths and negative behavior have been handled. Students are like new. Almost every student in the school is an active member of the UCE club.	
Trinity Vocation	3	1	Thanks given to UCE for the great work done. Before UCE, students had developed a habit of escaping from school. They would remove their uniforms to go out for drugs and alcohol to the nearest trading centers (Musasa and Kyalhumba). Since UCE, the students' behaviour and academic performance has greatly improved.	
St. Theresa Girls School	4	0	Before UCE, sex had become a normal activity in the school almost every day including reports of a sex scandal where a girl would escape to the nearby trading center lodges. Ten girls had been suspended. After UCE there has been no similar report.	
Mutanywana SS (In 2013 this school had 2nd highest rate of pregnancies and school dropouts in Kasese district.)	8	1-2	Before UCE, some teachers were having sexual relationships with students. After the UCE team stepped in with message of abstinence and chastity, there is a great reason for both teachers and students to smile. The UCE message was a double edged sword that has helped us all.	
Maliba SS (In 2013, this school had the highest rate of pregnancies and school dropouts in Kasese district.)	9	3	Before UCE outreaches and forming UCE Clubs, 10- 15 boys and girls per term were lost to early marriages and pregnancies. Most parents and children could not understand the value of education until UCE. Now there is a tremendous change in the students' behaviors and attitudes towards remaining in school and goal setting.
